Team Spotlight



Hello! My name is Lana and I am the Program and Support Coordinator at Alpha House.

I have many varying duties in my role.
Some of my key responsibilities include working with clients to arrange aid from outside agencies (such as Legal Aid, Manitoba Housing), offering practical support in areas like money management, providing one-on-one restorative (nervous system and spiritual health) care, and administrative assistance for the Executive Director.

Alpha House provides wrap-around services for our clients. When a woman begins our program, we start with her basic needs. Women and children often come to us with no hope, no resources, and only the clothing on their backs. In the first few weeks, I help them establish safe homes/practices and adequate food.

In addition to food, clothing, and shelter needs, our clients and their families often arrive with unaddressed health issues. This could look like a woman navigating the world nearly blind because her glasses were broken by her abuser. It could be that she is in dire need of dental or health care because she was not allowed to leave the home for years, especially after being subject to physical violence. These matters are essential to address early on.

Once their urgent needs are addressed, I start introducing practices to help regulate women's nervous systems and develop feelings of purpose and

belonging. Not only have our clients recently experienced crisis, but they inevitably have a long history of trauma. Their exposure to fear and harm has left them sensitive and reactive to perceived danger - but also numb and disconnected from their life and bodies. Trauma and abuse can cause challenges with reasoning, logic, memory, focus, and emotional wellbeing. These factors make healing and rebuilding perspective extremely challenging.

When our clients finally have their basic survival stabilized, they have the capacity to address other aspects of their lives. This is the point at which they get the most benefit from assistance with life skills, such as cleaning and organizing, meal planning and shopping, as well as money management. Together, we begin to prepare for their future independence. This means looking at housing and furnishing options. It also means assisting the client with developing resources that will help her continue moving toward a better future. Nothing is more heartwarming in this work than a past client reconnecting to share their happiness and success.
